
What is the reason behind this type of giant nevus? Is it due to eclipses during pregnancy?

In my 35 years as a doctor, I've never seen anything like this. I was in Tanzania for half a year. I saw a few patients with CMN. Besides control and resection of suspicious lesions, not much could be done.

Diagnosis

I have consulted three doctors from Delhi and Mumbai. Everyone has a different opinion and method. So confused by now.

MRI results showed "98%" was clear". They did not use contrast and therefore could not say 100%. I am thinking about pushing through for another MRI to be done with contrast.



Our neurologist gave some very scary statics: 50% chance it will turn to melanoma, which is fatal. Unknown but likely possibility of fine motor skill and/or cognitive deficits. After the jaw-dropping 30 minute appointment we left.



His incision had 100 stitches in his back and neck. It did not remain closed. He was discharged, and we drove the 2.5 hours home. The next day his wound appeared abnormal and I drove him all the way back.

While he was getting his haircut two guys started laughing at him hysterically and said "that haircut won't help him with all those moles."

Someone noticed my daughter's shirt was soaked with blood. She had no idea what tore her nevus skin this time. On the back she can't see it or bandage it herself... making her feel helpless and frustrated.





Do we stay and fight the unknown and try to give him more time. Should I swoop him up and take him to the places he wants to go, or do I ask for more treatments and hope that we still have that time.



USA

We had a port placed in my son and started immunotherapy on the same day. The port placement was probably the second worst surgery he had out of eight. It was painful and it took weeks for him to recover. It had to be placed on the opposite side because the shunt was placed on his right side. The infusion was long.

Immunotherapy takes time to work and it takes planning. It should be used in conjunction with radiation to really make it effective quicker. This disease just does not give you that kind of time.






